



Invitation to a “Summer School Renewable Energies“

Experiment e.V. is a non-profit organisation that encourages exchanges between peoples of all cultures, religions and age groups. It is the German branch of the oldest exchange organisation: The Experiment in International Living with organisations in 23 countries. In cooperation with the German Ministry of Foreign Affairs, we are delighted to invite students from Egypt, Tunisia and Morocco to a “Summer School Renewable Energies” in Bonn.

WHO?

The program is organized for younger university students that are enrolled at a university in Egypt (15 students), Tunisia (15 students) or Morocco (2 students). They should be able to speak English fluently.

WHY?

The aim of the Summer School is to offer insight into the subject of “Renewable Energies” and its varied aspects. The students will learn which economical benefits and development opportunities are linked to an economical and considerate exploitation of energy resources. Moreover, a more sustainable approach to work and life will be a focus of this Summer School.

WHEN? WHERE?

The Summer School will take place in Bonn, Germany from August 29th, 2012 – September 10th, 2012.

WHAT ABOUT?

Expert led lectures but also presentations that will be prepared by the participants in advance will deal with subjects like the potential and different ways of utilizing renewable energies. The ecological evaluation of renewable energies as well as the national and global impact of regenerative energies will be discussed in depth. The students will focus on the future and on intermediate-term perspectives of renewable energies. The focus will be on the Northern Africa countries as renewable energies are here often seen as an important aspect for the economical development. To understand the economical relevance of this subject the students will not only listen to lectures and presentations but will also visit companies who specialised successfully on renewable energies and engage in varied discussions with their representatives.

COST?

The Summer School is a scholarship program. The costs for accommodation (in double rooms) in a Guest House, 3 meals a day, participation in the program, costs for the flight and insurance will be covered by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Germany. The participants will only need some pocket money for their own expenses.

APPLICATION AND DEADLINE

Students interested in the Summer School should apply for the program until June 1st, so that there is a reasonable amount of time to select the participants, to handle visa applications and to make travel arrangements. All application sheets will be sent to Experiment e.V. in Germany and the decision on who will participate in the program will be made by June 10th at the latest.
